 - If you live with your spouse/ parent researcher: a copy of the rental agreement + a copy of electricity, gas, landline telephone or internet access bill or a house insurance certificate.
- Residence permit of spouse/ parent researcher or “récépissé” of his/her residence permit application
- Hosting agreement of spouse/parent researcher with his/her employment contract
- Proof of cohabitation (“déclaration de communauté de vie” document available at CMI Brest).
