Thank you for putting the documents in the following order:

- Currently valid passport: ID page + photocopies of all pages with visas, stamps and writing
- Currently valid residence permit or Long Stay visa with proof of its validation
- Birth certificate specifying filiation
- If applicable, marriage certificate
- 3 passport photographs meeting the specific standards required by the French authorities:

- Proofs of residence (**less than 3 months old**)
 - If you live with your spouse/ parent scientist: a copy of the rental agreement + a copy of electricity, gas, landline telephone or internet access bill or a house insurance certificate.
- Residence permit of spouse/parent researcher
- Hosting agreement of spouse/ parent researcher stipulating that the mobility is part of an agreement between at least two research organisations located in at least two EU member states. The hosting agreement is established between the researcher and the research organisation in the first member state.
- Proof of cohabitation (“Déclaration de communauté de vie” – document available at CMI Brest).
