CMI Brest - How to exchange your driving license

Any driver with a driving license issued by a country not belonging to the European Union can drive with his title in France for a period of one year from the acquisition of his normal residence in France (first residence permit or sticker OFII). Valid driving license shall nevertheless be accompanied, if it is not written in French, of an official translation with legalization or apostille.

Beyond this period of one year, this licence is no longer valid to drive in France.

- The exchange of a driving license is to be requested during one-year after you got your 1rt residence permit. Beyond this deadline, the
 exchange cannot take place and the driver will have to pass the exams to get a French driving licence if he/she wishes to drive.
- If you hold a residence permit indicating the status of "étudiant-élève", you can drive in France throughout the validity of this title IF you got your license before you entered French territory with the visa that gives you now the right to study here. The exchange of foreign driving license will be requested in case of change of status on the residence permit Beware! If you got your licence during summer holidays in your country while you were already a student in France, your licence is not valid in France!

- The exchange can take place only if France has a reciprocal agreement with the country that issued your driving title. The list of countries with which a reciprocal agreement has been concluded Figure here
- To be exchanged, your driver's license must still be valid.
- You must have the minimum age for driving in France and must not have been subject to sanctions, suspension or cancellation of driving licenses in the country of origin as provided in exchange or in the case a previous document issued in France.
